- Improve the effectiveness and efficiency of Cal U's pre-award and post-award processes

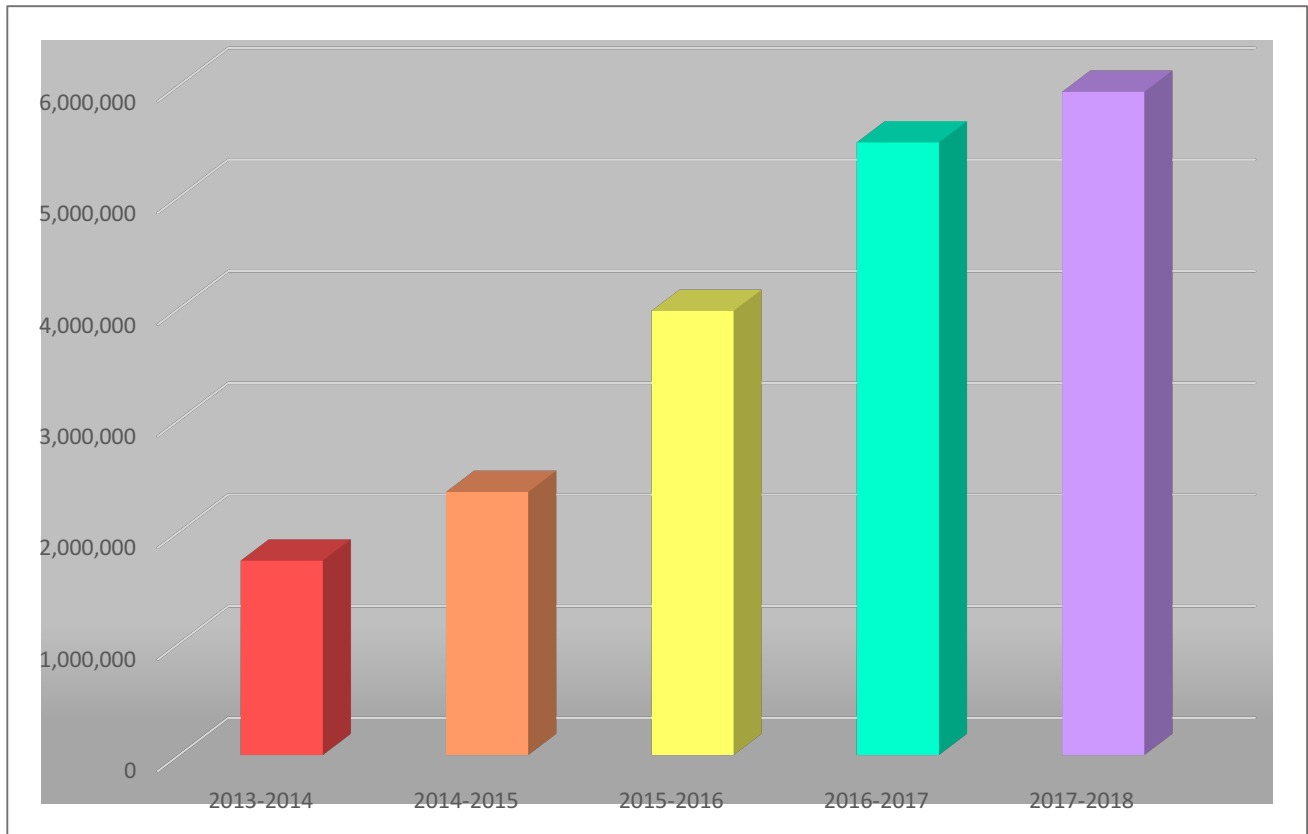
2017-18 Activities:

 - 3 staff members from University AdvancementFunded awards included 12 federal, 6 state, and 14 private.

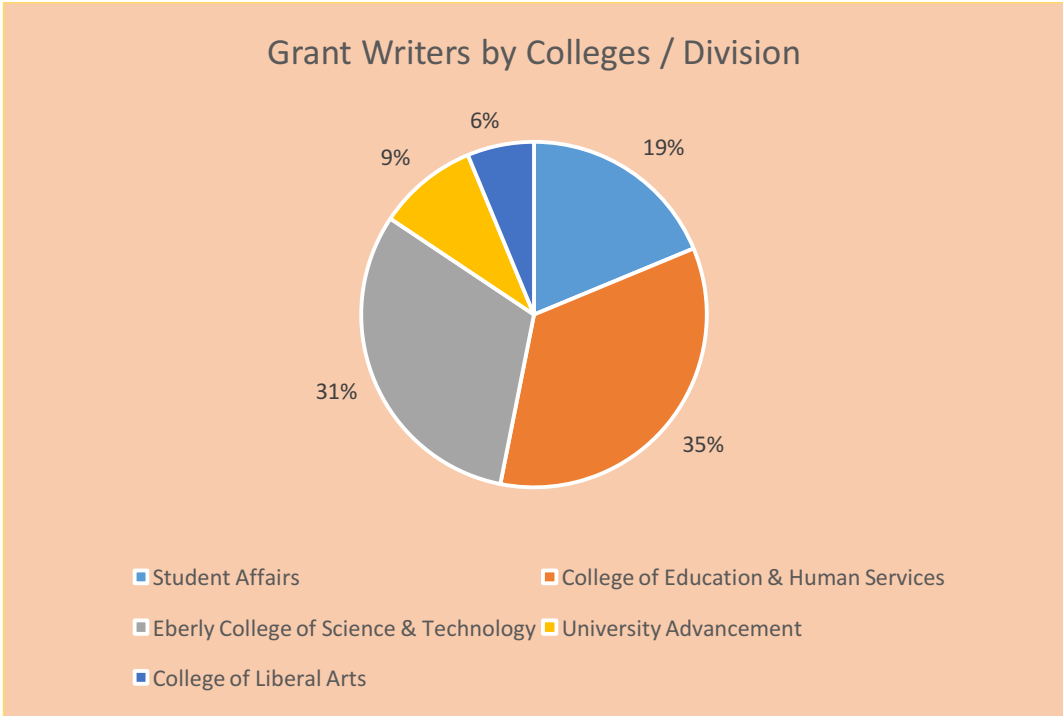
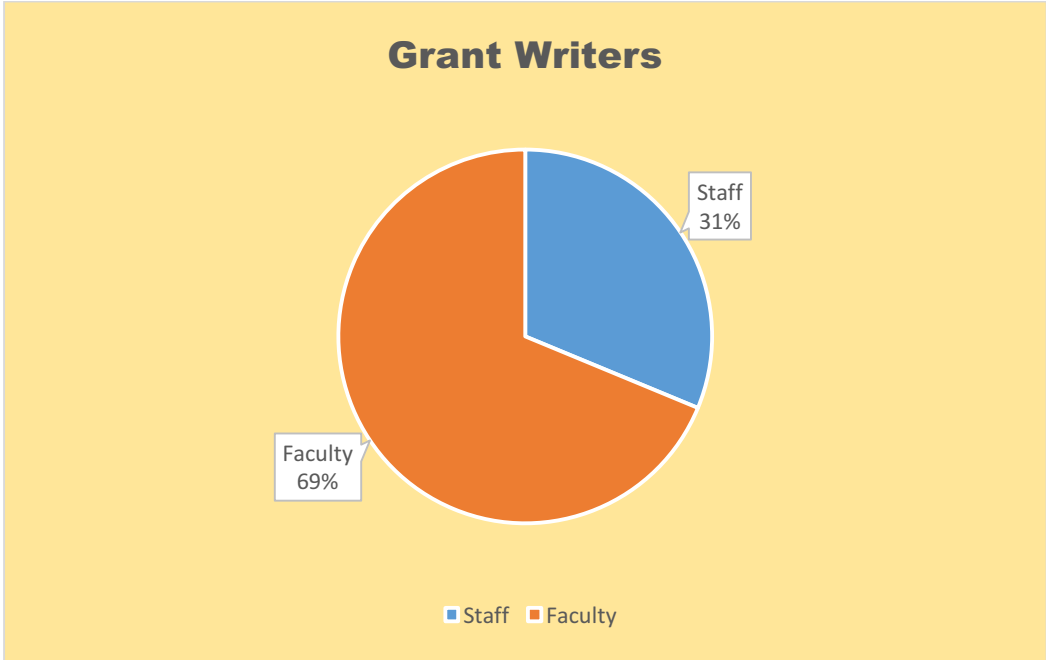

Yearly Comparison

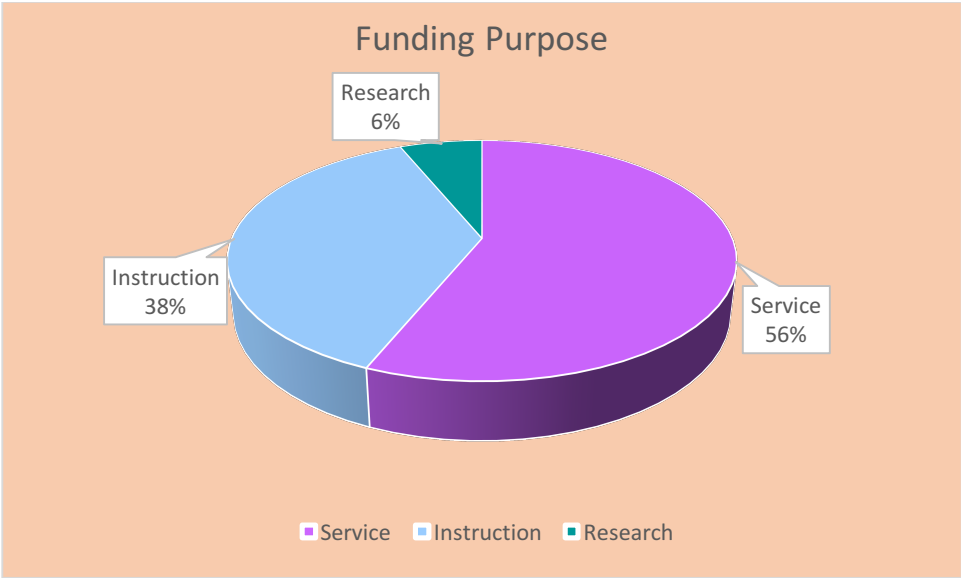
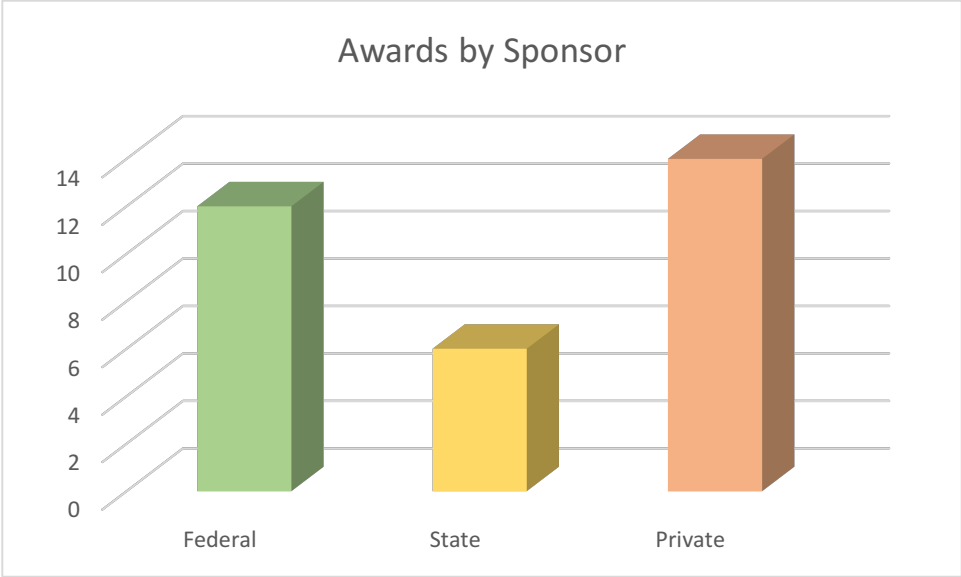
